



## **Survivor Camp Rules and Information**

Arrive at camp Monday June 10, 2019 with a picnic lunch. Upon arrival you will check in, picnic, and walk over the camp ground with other campers to choose your campsite. Depart Friday, June 14, 2019 at noon. Cost of camp is \$125.00 payable to Anita Kelley or Concord Baptist Church. Camp forms and payment are due May 19, 2019. Late forms will have a \$25.00 fee added to the cost of camp.

This year will be different from previous years. The theme for this year is Walk it Off. We will be discovering the many ways we can walk away from negatives and into positives through Jesus Christ. Camp rules and games will also be slightly different. This year you may bring anything you wish that you believe will help you soar during camp. Do remember to bring your Bible, and a drink container with a lid. Everyone will be issued an air mattress. You will need to bring your own bed roll, sleeping bag and pillow, or blanket and sheet. Remember that all clothing should be old and modest. We will have lots of competition that can ruin clothing. Everyone will be required to wear a t-shirt with sleeves over swim wear. Don't forget your towel.

Each day your team will be issued a food basket. You must decide how to use it as a team. The challenges are both physical and mental. Dumb luck also factors into many of the games. Everyone has an equal chance of winning. The main goal is to draw near to God. Remember, you will be participating as part of a team. Group time at camp is amazing!
